## 3.3 Self-Assessment Requirement

All candidates must complete a comprehensive self-assessment using the official IQ2LT Self-Assessment Grid before submitting their application. This internal evaluation helps identify strengths and areas for improvement, and serves as the foundation for your application portfolio.

# 4. Application Process

#### 4.1 Overview

The IQ2LT accreditation process follows a structured, documentation-based approach designed to thoroughly evaluate your institution through comprehensive review of submitted materials. The complete process typically takes 4-6 months from initial application to final decision.

## 4.2 Step-by-Step Process

Step 5	Additional Information	Provide clarifications or additional documents if requested (2-3 weeks)	
Step 6	Evaluation Report	Evaluation team prepares comprehensive assessment report (3-4 weeks)	
Step 7	Decision	Accreditation committee reviews report and makes final decision	
Step 8	Accreditation Award	Certificate issued and institution listed in IQ2LT registry

- · All documentation must be submitted in English or with certified English translations
- Incomplete applications will not be processed until all required materials are received
- Application fees are non-refundable regardless of accreditation outcome
- Institutions may request technical assistance during the preparation phase

## 2. Required Documentation

Your application package must include all documents listed below. Please use the official Document Checklist to ensure completeness. All documents should be clearly labeled and organized according to the categories specified.

#### 3.6 Rating Scale

Each criterion is rated on a five-point scale:

- · Level 5 Excellent: Exceeds standards with evidence of innovation and best practices
- Level 4 Very Good: Fully meets standards with strong evidence
- Level 3 Good: Meets standards with adequate evidence
- Level 2 Developing: Partially meets standards, requires improvement
- Level 1 Insufficient: Does not meet standards, significant improvement needed

To receive accreditation, institutions must achieve a minimum average rating of 3.0 across all dimensions, with no individual dimension rated below 2.5.

## 4. Timeline and Fees

#### 4.1 Timeline

The typical accreditation timeline from application to decision is 4-6 months, depending on the complexity of your institution, the completeness of documentation, and responsiveness in providing requested information.

- Evaluation fees vary based on institutional size: small (\$500), medium (\$2,250), large (\$3,000)
- Fees cover comprehensive documentation review and evaluation report preparation
- Payment plans may be available upon request
- All fees are subject to change with 90 days notice
